## **TRAVEL REMINDERS**





Be prepared for the requirements that you may be expected to comply with before, during your trip, and once you arrive in the United States. It is your RESPONSIBILITY to be up to date with the latest information.



Check with your Airline for travel updates

Travel with your valid I-20 travel signature, F-1 visa & passport

Check with your airline about travel and learn about your country's travel status via local sources.

## 5 month rule

5 MONTH RULE (What we know today) According to USCIS COVID guidance dated 23 March 2020: five-month temporary absence provision addressed in 8 C.F.R. 214.2(f)(4) will not apply for students who remain in Active status.

#### **COVID 19 Vaccination Information at FIU**



Vaccination guidance for international students

FIU does not require any students or employees to get a COVID-19 vaccination, although we highly recommend it for your own benefit, While evidence shows that people who are vaccinated can get COVID-19, their symptoms are usually milder. If you are unvaccinated, you are assuming a significant risk to your health.

Following the guidance of Governor Ron DeSantis and the Florida Board of Governors, this fall classes will be back on campus with no remote option and no physical distancing in our classrooms. There are no plans to modify the operations of the university to accommodate individuals who choose not to get vaccinated.

What follows is guidance for unvaccinated students who wish to get vaccinated, partially vaccinated students, and students who will work in healthcare facilities where vaccinations are mandatory:

## **ENROLLMENT GUIDELINES**

TERMS	UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS	GRADUATE STUDENTS
FALL OR SPRING SEMESTERS	12 credits (Fall & Spring) Max 3 credits online	9 credits (Fall & Spring) Max 3 credits online
SUMMER A/C	12 Credits if first semester (Optional for continuing students)	6 credits if first semester (Optional for continuing students)
SUMMER B	6 credits if first semester (Optional for continuing students)	3 credits if first semester (Optional for continuing students)
EXCEPTIONS	RCL- completion of degree or medical RCL	PhD students advancing to thesis/dissertation, RCL- completion of degree



## **LEAVE OF ABSENCE- RETURNING STUDENTS**

- If you previously requested a LOA and plan to come back to the United States in Fall 2021, you must access FIU ISSS PORTAL select and submit a <u>Return to the US After</u> <u>Authorized Leave of Absence Request</u>
- DSO will work with SEVP on requesting a correction request to your student record and you will be notified once a decision is made
- If Approved your SEVIS record will be set back to Active status for Fall 2021
- If Denied, you must then submit a RESTART I-20

Whether you are a new, transfer, or continuing student, this information below is intended to provide you with all the details and instructions to follow for FALL 2021 (subject to change based on SEVP Guidance). Please read all the information very carefully, and follow instructions accordingly based on your situation and location. #### **FALL 2021-NEW STUDENTS Guidance**

IMPORTANT: If you started your program in the Spring/Summer 2021 but stayed in your country studying remotely and now you are coming to the United States, then FALL 2021 will be considered your first semester as an F-1 student and you are expected to enroll as follows:

- O New Students Studying in the United States in Fall 2021
- New Students Starting Program Overseas and coming to the U.S. in Spring 2022

## FOR GRADUATING STUDENTS

- USCIS still processing OPT/STEM applications you must be in the US to apply
- When do you apply? 90 Days before program end date and up to 45 days after program end date
- All standing regulations are still considered in effect- there are no policy or guidance changes to OPT regulations - no extensions
- USCIS processing time 90-120 days some delays should be expected
- Remote work allowed for U.S. based companies
- OPT Travel Rule no travel on OPT without employment- No COVID 19 exceptions in place
- o If travelling must have a valid Travel signature, F-1 visa & passport

### **SOCIAL SECURITY & DMV**

Check for local Social Security offices openings to the public for in-person service.

Check for FLHSMV offices openings in your area. They are also providing services online at GoRenew.com, by telephone and email

60 days grace period extension



You must present original documents, not accepting photocopies or notarized copies. All documents must be current (not expired).
