














END OF PROGRAM & DEPARTURE



30 DAY GRACE PERIOD

All J-1 students have 30 days after the end of their program to return home.



60 DAY GRACE PERIOD

All F-1 students have 60 days after the end of their program or OPT to change to a new status, transfer to a new school or program, or go home.

WITHDRAWAL FROM PROGRAM



When a student leaves the US brfore finishing their program of study, they have 15 days after dropping classes to depart the US.



You must have authorization from ISSS before dropping your classes.



ENROLLMENT GUIDELINES

FALL OR SPRING SEMESTERS	12 credits (Fall & Spring) Max 3 credits online	9 credits (Fall & Spring) Max 3 credits online
SUMMER A/C	12 Credits if first semester (Optional for continuing students)	6 credits if first semester (Optional for continuing students)
SUMMER B	6 credits if first semester (Optional for continuing students)	3 credits if first semester (Optional for continuing students)
EXCEPTIONS	RCL- completion of degree or medical RCL	PhD students advancing to thesis/dissertation, RCL- completion of degree



ONLIINE COURSES

Only one online course (3 credits) will be counted toward the full-time course load requirement. You may not take all courses online in your last term

UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS

9 credits on campus + 3 online = 12 credits

GRADUATE STUDENTS

6 credits on campus + 3 online = 9 credits



REDUCED COURSE LOAD

All reduced course load requests require ISSS authorization before you drop a course with OneStop.

Reduced course loads will only be approved for:

- Medical condition
- Completion of study
- Academic Difficulties

CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT

You may take classes at other institutions that count toward the fulltime enrollment requirement if:

- You are enrolled for at least 6 credits at FIU
- You get written permission from your Academic Advisor and ISSS

Document Request	(iv) Concurrent enrollment. An F-1 student may be enrolled in two different Service-approved schools at one time as long as the combined enrollment amounts to a full time course of study. In cases where a student is concurrently enrolled, the school from which the student will earn his or her degree or certification should issue the Form I-20, and conduct subsequent certifications and updates to the Form I-20. The DSO from this school is also responsible for all of the reporting requirements to the Service. In instances where a student is enrolled in programs with different full course of study requirements (e.g., clock hours vs. credit hours), the DSO is permitted to determine what constitutes a full time course of study.

ACADEMIC DISMISSAL

When your cumulative GPA falls below requirements for multiple semesters (you will receive warnings before being officially dismissed)

You will be out of status if you cannot successfully appeal this decision (and therefore continue enrollment at FIU)

Only options to avoid falling out of status are to IMMEDIATELY transfer to another U.S. school or depart the U.S.



TRAVEL & RE-ENTRY



To enter the US in F-1 status, you will need:

- A valid passport- valid until 6 months into the future
- A valid F-1 visa stamp
- Your FIU I-20 with an up-to-date travel signature

IF YOUR DOCUMENTS ARE NOT CORRECT, CBP MAY ISSUE YOU AN I-515A FORM.

CONTACT ISSS IMMEDIATELY.



TRAVEL & RE-ENTRY

You must request an ISSS advisor's signature on PAGE TWO of your I -20 at least 1 week before your intended travel date.

If you need to renew your F-1 visa, you MUST re-verify funding and request an updated I-20 for visa renewal

Automatic Visa Revalidation: Mexico, Canada, Caribbean – visit ISSS before your trip

ON CAMPUS EMPLOYMENT

Student MUST be maintaining valid F-1 status



Student must be ACTIVE IN PROGRAM AT FIU



Work LIMITED to 20 hours/week in Fall & Spring semesters



May work 21 hours or more during Summer or school breaks

ON CAMPUS EMPLOYMENT INFORMATION

OFF CAMPUS EMPLOYMENT





Practical training performed for academic credit that is required as part of the academic plan or program curriculum. Must be equal to your degree level.

One semester at a time, cannot be a regular job

CPT INFORMATION

OFF CAMPUS EMPLOYMENT

OPT



12 months (total) of employment authorization after graduation from each degree level

Authorization from USCIS in the form of an EAD (OPT card)

May use before or after graduation STEM students may apply for an extension





Top 5 international student rules to live by

1) Do not let your I-20 expire

2) Do not work on or off campus without ISSS Authorization

Always seek authorization from ISSS for Curricular Practical Training (CPT) when enrolling in an internship, Co-op or practicum whether it is paid or non-paid.



Always enroll full time during Fall and Spring semesters: 12 credits undergraduate | 9 credits graduate



Do not enroll in more than 3 credits online towards your full time enrollment







FAILURE TO MAINTIAN STATUS

ACTION

Remaining in the U.S. longer than authorized to do so

Failing to meet requirements or violating the terms of F-1 status

Studying part-time

Taking too many online classes

Engaging in unauthorized employment

Failing to complete your program

CONSEQUENCE

Denial of CPT and OPT

Denial of employment on campus

Termination of SEVIS record

Difficulty obtaining new visas and/or reentering U.S.

Possible deportation



REGAIN YOUR STATUS

01. REINSTATEMENT

Work with an immigration attorney to submit an application to USCIS while you continue taking classes and maintaining status



Receive a new I-20 with a new SEVIS ID#. Requires travel and return to the US and repayment of SEVIS fee.

DRIVERS LICENSE & TAXES

Please keep in mind that your I-20 must be active for you to get your license.


We appreciate your patience while we register all our new students!
